Since 1997 the application of implant dentistry to all areas of prosthetics has grown organically in Dr. Meek's practice and it has become the most rewarding part of private practice for him Currently Dr. Meek and his practice partner in Austin focus on restorative driven implant treatment.

Dr. Meek was awarded Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry (FAGD) in 2012 and has made the study of implant dentistry and prosthetics the center of his continuing education.
