direct composites with a simplified bonding and composite technique.

Techniques will be presented, demonstrated, and practiced to restore a Class II and a Class IV restoration in this HANDS-ON course using step-by-step clinical procedures.

Subjects discussed will include a wide range of direct resin uses, including predictable shade selection, simplified preparations, natural layering, multiple contact predictability and efficient finishing and polishing. Procedures reviewed will also include preventing post-operative sensitivity, flowable resin use, mixed media cases, indirect restoration blackout, previsualization, mockups, repairs/renewals, photography, and advanced aesthetics.

From those just starting to place direct resins to clinicians seeking advanced European artistry, valuable and practical direct resin pearls and composite gems gleaned from across the globe will be shared with attendees.
